LEAVE FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS - EXEMPT STAFF

Background

It is the privilege of any exempt staff employee of the District to offer himself/herself as a candidate for any public office for which they may be eligible.

Procedures

- 1. When an employee (exempt staff) is nominated as a candidate and wishes to contest a municipal, regional, provincial or federal election, they shall be given leave of absence, without pay, during the election campaign.
- 2. If the exempt staff employee is elected as a Member of Parliament or Member of the Legislative Assembly, they shall be granted a long-term leave of absence.
 - 2.1. The District agrees to grant the leave of absence without pay, not more than two (2) weeks after application.
- 3. Exempt Employees elected or appointed to municipal or regional district offices and/or public school boards shall be granted leave of absence with pay up to a maximum of five (5) days in any one (1) school year.
