## FORMAL RECEPTION AND PROM JUNE 24, 2022

The activities of June 24<sup>th</sup> will begin with a formal reception for all graduates, guests and family at St. Eugene Golf Resort and Casino in Cranbrook. It will continue with prom at the Cranbrook Curling Centre.

(Please note: Prom is a community led event. Mount Baker Secondary School and School District No. 5 are not responsible nor in charge of this event)

#### Formal Reception – 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

- Final Graduates and their guests are encouraged to attend the reception at St. Eugene from 4:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Friday, June 24<sup>th</sup>. We advise families to arrive as early as 3:30 to account for parking delays.
- > Graduates will be asked to line up for the Introductions and Grand March at **4:15 pm** to ensure the Grand March starts on time.
- Family members are welcome to attend, as there will be many opportunities to take photos. Family dress may be informal. As in years past, food and refreshments will **not** be provided. Water will be available for the graduates.
- You are welcome to bring a chair/lawn chair to this event, although limited seating will be provided.
- ➤ In case of inclement weather, the reception will be held at St. Eugene Golf Resort and Casino. Please bring an umbrella in the case of rain. Families are welcome to stay after 6:30 and take photos.

### <u>Prom – 8:30 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.</u>

- ➤ The prom is at the **Cranbrook Curling Centre** beginning at **8:30 p.m.**
- ➤ Wristbands for the prom will be issued with your ticket. Please bring your wristband to Prom as it will be your proof of ticker purchase.
- > Doors close at 9:30 p.m. graduates or guests will **NOT** be admitted after this time.
- ➤ If graduates or their guests leave the prom, they will **NOT** be allowed to return.
- No smoking, vaping, alcohol, drugs, tobacco/tobacco products, energy drinks or food allowed.
- > Semi-formal or formal attire is required. Graduates or their guests are not to change during the prom.
- There will be ample food and snacks to eat.
- > In addition to the music and dancing, there will be a variety of other fun activities and prizes.
- The event will conclude at 2:00 a.m.

## To all 2022 Grads, Guests and Parents:

**Please note:** Prom is a parent planned event made possible with many local community donations. **Mount Baker Secondary School and School District No. 5 are not in charge nor responsible for this event.** 

The 2022 Graduation Prom will be the highlight of your last year at Mount Baker Secondary School. The Parent Prom Committee, community members and countless other volunteers have worked hard to ensure that you enjoy a fun and safe prom evening. The 2022 prom, held at the **Cranbrook Curling Centre**, will undoubtedly be a gala event, which you will be proud and honoured to attend. The decor, entertainment, prizes, food and festivities will make it a memorable event. You will enjoy a casino area with a variety of tables to spend your prom casino money, a video DJ playing your most requested music, a photo station for prom themed photos and many more surprises. Throughout the evening there will be a chance for grads to win random prizes donated by many local businesses. There will also be a few grand prizes drawn throughout the evening. Grand prize winners must still be at the prom to collect their prize or another name will be drawn. Only graduates will be eligible for the random prize draws and the casino prize. The 2022 Parent Prom Committee is asking that you **READ AND FOLLOW** these responsible paths to help make your prom evening a huge success.

- 1. Students may invite one prepaid guest. **Guests must be in the age range of 16 years to 19 years**. The graduate is responsible for the conduct of their guest. All grads must have **PRE-PURCHASED** their Prom Tickets. Each graduate is eligible to receive an invitation to prom 2022, and their guest, two numbered wristbands, a gold one for the grad and a silver one for their guest. **These wristbands will serve as tickets into the prom.** The 2022 Prom Invitation is provided as a keepsake for the graduate. **Do not forget your wristbands and photo ID on prom night.** 
  - Dress is formal or semi-formal. Students will not be allowed to change into casual clothes.
  - The prom doors open at 8:30 p.m. and will close at 9:30 p.m.
  - Everyone will be asked to present photo ID when entering.
- 2. A very dedicated group of grad parents and volunteers have stepped up to ensure the graduates of 2022 have a wonderful prom experience. They are making every effort to ensure the safety of everyone involved the entire night. This is a **DRY/DRUG FREE GRAD**. For forty-five years, parents and volunteers have worked to prevent any type of accident which may result in injury or death. **The prom committee requests the cooperation of parents and students to ensure there is no indulgence in alcohol or drugs prior to prom.** 
  - No alcohol, drugs, vapes, cigarettes or tobacco products, energy drinks, food, or large purses/bags will be allowed in the event. If found, these items will be confiscated, and the student and their guest may not be permitted entry.
  - If the graduate or guest is deemed to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol, his/her parents will be contacted to escort them home.
  - There will be a first aid attendant on site during the entire prom event.
  - All graduates and their guests will need to clear security before entrance is allowed into the prom.
- 3. Once through security, the graduate and their guest will then go to the registration table where the wristbands and numbers will be checked off the master list and prom casino money for both the graduate and their guest will be handed out. Please remember the following details:
  - Only graduates and their guest will be admitted into the prom venue.

- Remember to bring your prom wristbands and photo ID along with you.
- Coats and purses will be checked into the coatroom prior to entering the prom main area to ensure their safety.
- 4. During the prom please remember:
  - Any disruptive behavior during the prom will not be tolerated and could cause you and/or your guest to be removed from the premises.
  - There is zero tolerance and NO admittance for students arriving under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol.
  - Once you leave the prom, you will not be permitted to re-enter.

#### **Mount Baker Secondary School Graduation Prom Guidelines:**

- Participation in graduation events/activities is a privilege that is earned and is contingent upon positive, responsible behavior at this event and other school events. Students and guests must be respectful, use appropriate language and act and dance appropriately.
- Grads may purchase a ticket for his/herself and one guest. Your guest must sign this contract (if the guest is a Mount Baker Grad, they must complete and sign their own contract). Grads are responsible for ensuring that their guest displays responsible and appropriate behavior.
- Prom guests must range in age from 16 − 19.
- Tickets are non-refundable and cannot be exchanged with another student. If your guest is unable to attend and you would like to bring someone else a new contract must be signed.
- Prom tickets and photo identification must be presented at the door by all grads and guests.
- This is a chemical free event. Smoking, alcohol and illegal substances are not permitted. Parents will be contacted to pick up the graduate and/or guest if they are found to be in possession of, or under the influence of drugs or alcohol. ZERO TOLERANCE with NO REFUND.
- All individuals attending will be subject to search by security.
- Grads and guests cannot leave the prom area after entering.
- First Aid attendants will be on site. If you require assistance contact security.
- Formal or semi-formal attire is required. Attendees will not be allowed to change during prom.
- Individuals who fail to comply with the above rules will be asked to leave immediately and parents/guardians will be contacted to pick them up.
