#### 6. **ITEMS FORWARDED FROM PREVIOUS MEETING**

- 6.1. Draft Policy - School Board Operations
  - Trustee Johns reviewed changes made to the Draft Policy.
  - Trustees were asked to review Policy 1.2 Procedural Bylaw to ensure nothing has been missed in this Draft Policy on School Board Operations.
  - The Draft Policy, with noted changes to Page 9, will be sent out to partner • groups for feedback.
- 6.2. Draft Policy - Union Distribution of Information
  - The District's Draft Policy is a combination of a draft policy from January • 2011 and the current Interim Agreement between the BCTF and BCPSEA.
  - This Agreement will be reviewed again between April 30th and May 3rd. It • is possible that changes could be made to the Agreement.
  - Discussion ensued about whether it is necessary to have a District Policy if • the Agreement would supersede it.
  - CFTA stated they are respectful of the interim memorandum agreement • and is willing to work with the District to ensure all teachers are aware of the Agreement.
  - The Committee agreed that there is no need for a policy at this time.

#### 7. **CORRESPONDENCE AND/OR NEW ITEMS**

- 7.1. Committee Terms of Reference Review
  - Discussion ensued regarding the history of Education items (beginning in • April 2009) being referred to the Advocacy Committee to help move Policy along more efficiently.
  - The Committee agreed this should be a permanent move and the Terms of • Reference for both Committees should be adjusted accordingly.

# **RECOMMENDATION A**

That Policy 1.4 Terms of Reference - Education/Policy Committee be renamed 'Terms of Reference - Policy Committee' and that Policy 1.6 Terms of Reference - Advocacy Committee' be renamed Terms of Reference Advocacy/Education Committee' and the wording in each policy be modified to reflect these procedural changes.

- 7.2. Section 3 Policy Review
  - Mrs. Casault advised that all policies in Section 3 are being reviewed.
  - Please notify Mrs. Casault if there are any particular policies that you feel should be dealt with right away.
- **7.3.** BAA Course -Trades Work 12
  - Mr. McPhee provided background to the course.
  - District is working in collaboration with the College of the Rockies.
  - This is an opportunity to provide students entering the workforce after graduation with some pre-employment skills and knowledge before they graduate.
  - Policy 3.19 Locally Developed Courses will need to be updated as the Ministry requirements have changed.

# RECOMMENDATION B

"That the BAA Course - Trades Work 12 be sent to the Board of Education for approval."

- 7.4. Criminal Records Check
  - Trustee Whalen advised there seems to be confusion as to when a Criminal Records Check should be done at the school level.
  - Mr. McPhee advised that a Criminal Records Check is required when someone outside the school district that does already have a Criminal Records Check, works with students in an unsupervised capacity. These District expectations should be communicated again to schools.
  - Mrs. Casault is currently looking at developing a Criminal Records Check Policy.
  - Clearer parameters on the longevity of the Record Checks also need to be addressed.
  - A Draft Policy will be brought back to a future meeting.
- **7.5.** Alcohol and PAC Fund Raising
  - Lengthy discussion ensued.
  - It was agreed that no School District function can involve the use of alcohol in any way.
  - Policy 2.13 Consumption of Alcohol Beverages on School District Property will be amended to include this information.
- 7.6. BCSTA Policy on Personal Use of Social Media
  - Trustee Ayling referenced a newly released policy for Trustees from BCSTSA on the personal use of social media. Should the Board ever

decide to create a policy on the personal use of social media, it needs to be in accordance with the Charter of Rights and Freedoms Act.

- Discussion ensued regarding what is appropriate/inappropriate (i.e. Should • teachers have students on their social sites?)
- District staff will review and bring back to a future meeting. •
