### **JOB DESCRIPTION**

**JOB TITLE:** JOURNEYMAN - PAINTER

**JOB SUMMARY:** An employee hired to perform skilled painting maintenance work of the school district. A general expectation that "cross-trade" co-operation will be expected. This employee is responsible to an assigned supervisor.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:**

1. Grade 12 or equivalent
2. Valid British Columbia Journeyman Certification
3. Valid British Columbia Driver's License
4. Minimum three years' experience in the painting trade.

#### **MUST HAVE THE ABILITY TO:**

1. Communicate effectively, orally and in writing.
2. Maintain confidentiality.
3. Proven ability to troubleshoot and solve problems related to the position.
4. Be self directed, flexible and work independently.
5. Deal with disagreeable conditions.
6. Operate, maintain and repair a variety of tools and equipment related to the certification required.
7. Read and understand specialized and technical material related to the painting trades.
8. Work under pressure and meet deadlines.
9. Identify and apply a range of mathematical concepts.
10. Keep current with all codes and regulations pertaining to the position.
11. Understand the safety requirements of working with hazardous materials and/or situations.
12. Co-ordinate work with other trades.
13. Develop work methods to handle assigned tasks.
14. Perform the physical requirements of the job.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:**

1. Inspect, diagnose, and ascertain, repair and paint district buildings, furniture playground equipment and signs.
2. Responsible for the purchase of supplies and services relating to the position.
3. Acquire product information new and old.
4. Be attuned to detail and color selections.
5. Provide information to school district of potentially serious and/or dangerous situations.
6. Liaise with community agencies and general contractors.
7. Maintain, clean, service, adjust or repair tools and equipment related to the position.

8. Assist with the technical design of new buildings and renovations.
9. Comply with all codes and regulations related to the position.
10. Perform other job related duties.
