- Communicate effectively and work cooperatively with students, district and school staff
- Demonstrate involvement with initiatives and work with related PLC groups
- Maintain currency on the developments in technology to facilitate learning;
- Work with student information systems such as MYEDBC at the school and district level
- Carry out and further develop programs connected to the District's learning and technology
- Provide support and marking for any Provincial level assessments FSA?
- Other duties as assigned
