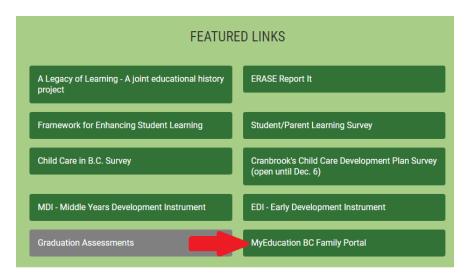

This guide provides instructions for logging in to <u>MyEducation BC</u> for the first time, completing the security verification steps, and changing passwords.

LOGGING IN

Visit the school district website. Click the MyEducation BC link under the featured links at the bottom of the page.



Or alternatively the Students/Parents Tab, Select

to initialize your account

*Once your Login account is activated, you will be able to use a smartphone/tablet to access all info in the system.



Pop Ups should be **enabled** for some features of the site to work properly.



Passwords are good for 90 days to protect student's data and you will be prompted to change your password.

The following login fields will appear.

Login ID: type in the login name provided to you ("sd5-firstinitiallastname")

Password: type in the password provided to you.



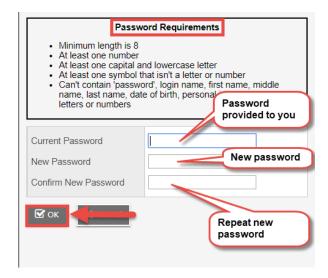
Click the **Log On** button. If this is the very first log-in with this username and password, you will be prompted to immediately change the password and to provide additional information.



In the new pop-up window:

Current Password: enter the password used on the first log-in screen.

New Password: enter the new password, observing the password rules in the *Password Requirements* information.



Passwords must meet the following criteria:

Minimum length is 8
At least one number
At least one capital letter
At least one lowercase letter
At least one symbol that isn't a letter or number
Cannot contain login name, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal id, or only sequential letters or numbers.



Confirm New Password: enter the new password again.

Click OK.

A *Security Preferences Update* window will appear, asking for additional information to be used if a password is forgotten.

Primary email: enter your primary email address that was used to create the account.

Security question: use the drop-down menu to select a question you will remember the answer to.

Security answer: enter the answer to the security question selected. For privacy reasons, you may observe more characters than what your answer entails.

Confirm answer: enter the same answer to the security question selected.

Click Submit.

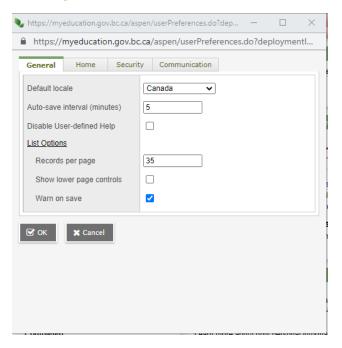

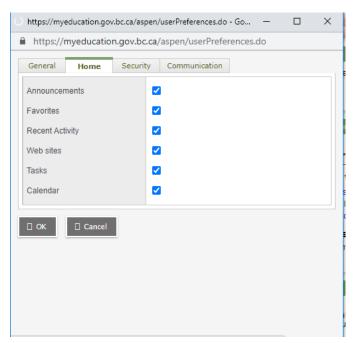


The Set Preferences dialog box appears. Complete preferences as shown below. Click OK.

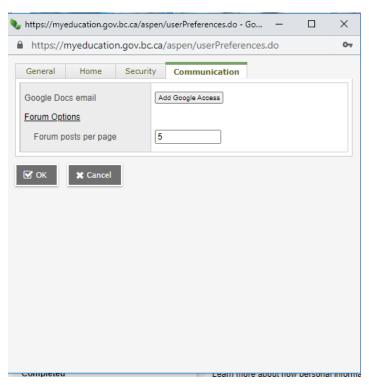

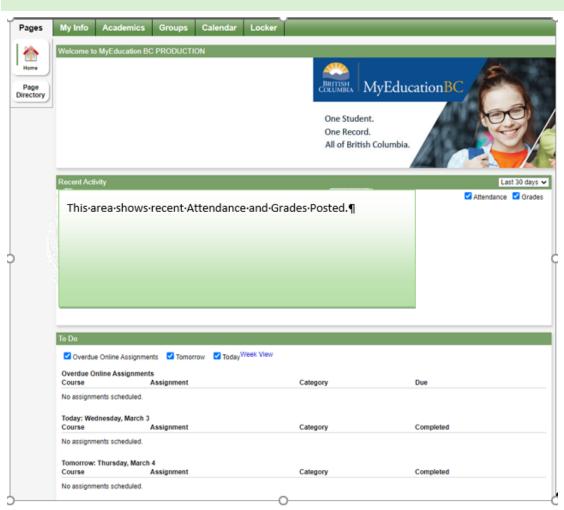

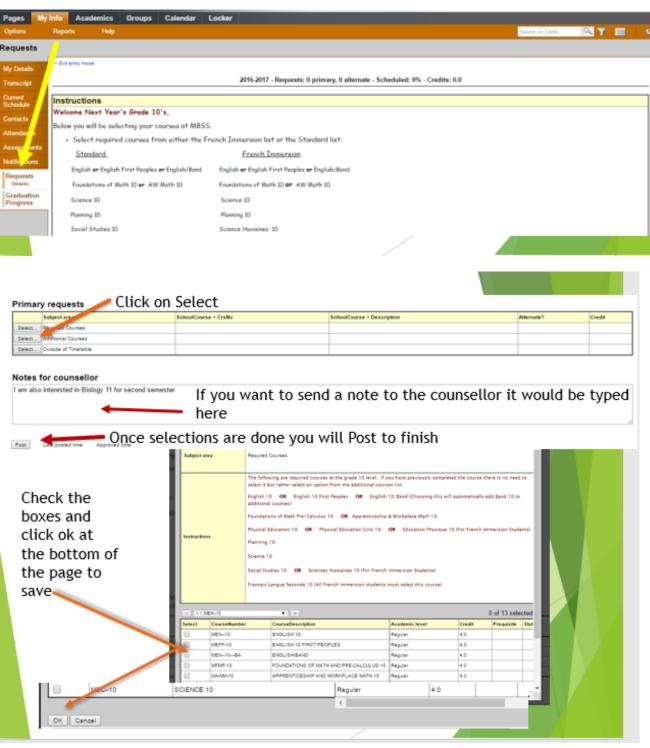
COURSE SELECTION PROCESS
