I cannot thank enough the dedicated staff and parents involved in helping to make our school the wonderful place it is! I am always humbled by the generosity and care of our KO family members.



Reinarz/Schadeli


Forest Creatures: Rabbit, Skunk, Deer, Bear, Squirrel, etc. No masks that cover the face. Face paint would be great.




Indigenous Leadership Group

Next gathering for Grade 5 & 6 Indigenous students happening on December 7th. Lunch will be provided. Miss Alexis will provide more information closer to the date.


Free Family Hockey & Skate

Our Panago Pizza Night fundraiser is in the works! On December 12th, \$5 from every large pizza will be given back to the school and will be added to our fundraising efforts.


