Principal's Message


Dear Kootenay Orchards Families,

Don't forget to set your clock back on Sunday, November 5th!!




Pets on the School Ground

Halldorson/Potter


Heroes: Knight, Archer, etc.

Mass Choir




Christmas Bells are Around the Corner.




Questions to ask your child with any book:








Breakfast Fridays at Kootenay Orchards!!


This free take-away breakfast is open to all students and can be picked up from the school kitchen between 8:15-8:45 am.


