forward in our journey together.


Let us be thankful and grateful for our families, and our Kootenay Orchards Community.

for Parent-Teacher conferences. On these days, <u>students</u>


<u>will be dismissed at 12:05pm</u>. Teachers will be sending home more information with students.

Before School:


 Friendly reminder that student supervision is provided before the start of school starting at 8:20 am. Supervision is not provided before this time.

In the event that your child is late, please have them check in with the school office so that we know they have arrived and can mark them present.




Girls: Mondays and Wednesdays right after school.



Our Grade 6 students will have an opportunity to volunteer to help prepare and cook the meals.



Halloween Carnival Monday, October 30th

PAC is excited to announce the return of their Halloween Carnival on Monday, October 30th!! This is a fun-filled evening for families where children can play Halloween Carnival Games to collect stamps and redeem for prizes, time in a Mega Bouncy Castle or snacks from the concession stand.

To attend the Halloween Carnival, families will need to purchase a Carnival Passport. This Passport will be used to collect the stamps that can be redeemed for prizes. To accommodate the large number of families expected to attend, the Halloween Carnival will be divided into two sessions and each session will have a set number of Carnival Passports available for purchase.
