

Immersive Reader

Immersive is a full screen reading experience that helps improve reading and writing for students.

Students can access **via Office365 by signing in** with their student account and accessing Word online. It is available in other Microsoft products and is accessed via **view tab**.

This is a **free app** for reading – which can help all readers.

In Word (accessed via Office365 on the portal) students will access immersive reader through the **view tab**.

The app will simplify the text experience for the user and can be adjusted to fit their unique needs as a learner. The user has the ability to change:

- word and line highlighter
- voice speed, tone
- visual crowding (spacing)
- fonts
- colour themes (reduce glare)
- text size
- grammar options (syllables, parts of speech, etc.)
- line focus (reading ruler)
- picture dictionary (for the text they are working with)

- translation (60 different languages)
