Venn Diagram HINTS

- **1.** All three mirrors reflect light rays to form an image.
- **2.** A **PLANE** mirror makes an image that is the same size as the object.
- **3.** A **CONCAVE** mirror would produce an image that is larger than the ACTUAL object.
- A CONVEX mirror would produce an image that is smaller than the ACTUAL object.
