
## The Coldest Night of the Year

The Coldest Night of the Year is a covid-safe, family-friendly walk to raise money for charities serving people experiencing homelessness, hurt, and hunger.



Raisin Pudding With Sauce

cup Flour (la farin)
 tsp Baking Powder (poodr a pate)
 tsp Salt (li sel)
 TBSP Butter (li beur)
 TBSP Sugar (li seuk)
 cup Raisins (dii raazayn)
 cup Brown Sugar (li seuk brun)
 TBSP Butter (li beur)
 3/4 cup Boiling Water (dii loo)

Mix flour, sugar, salt, baking powder, and raisins. Melt butter (2 TBSP) and mix with milk. Stir wet ingredients into dry ingredients until just mixed.


Spread the mixture into a greased baking dish.

Boil water and add butter (1 TBSP) and brown sugar. Stir then pour over the mixture in he baking dish.


Bake at 350 degree F for 30 min. Allow the pudding to cool for 15-30 min before serving (this allows the sauce to thicken).
