A basketball tournament was hosted this weekend. DSAC students went to Fernie today, examined cell phone policy, and discussed Mission, Vision and Values for SD5. Next week will be the Capstone exhibition Feb 28, 1:30 to 3:00 pm. Invitation to PAC members to come out and view the exhibition. Black History Month started with an assembly, a lot of it was led by students. There are lots of posters around the school celebrating Black Excellence.
