Nicole has been in contact with Penny regarding the Chamber Community Grant. The PAC will apply for this grant with the main request for funds to go towards the Ninja Playground Project. Next applications open up in the Fall. UPDATE: PAC provided Penny Lowe and K&J Street Consulting with information in order to apply for BC Community Grant in a effort to secure the remainder of funds for the Ninja Playground. Application deadline August 3<sup>rd</sup>. As far as we know the application was submitted on behalf of SSS PAC and Ninja Playground Committee. No update received if Grant was received by Ms Lowe or not.

2. 2022/2023 Scholarship/Bursary.

Action: Nicole will reach out to Sharlene to see if she has received anything from anyone or if there is an application form used in previous year(s) for application submission for PAC Bursary. No previous application process in place. Sharlene reached out in January with no response. Nicole and Tiffany put together an application form to be used each year and forwarded to Sharlene who forwarded along to GRAD students. see attached.

FIVE applications were received. Nicole and Tiffany chose 2 applicants to each receive \$500 bursary from PAC. Tiffany attended Grad Ceremonies to present the bursary to the 2 recipients. The recipients were: Madison Hutchinson and Cailey McLean. Madison Hutchinson has been in touch with post-secondary registration confirmation. PAC will send an etransfer once online banking has been sorted/received.
