### 4.1 Budget Update

The 2018/19 Budget was passed in June. We have been with busy keeping track of construction work over the summer.

- Enrollment in the district seems to be up so far from projections. There will still be some new registrations and withdrawals of students.
- ➤ Elementary schools in Cranbrook are up a total of 25 students. Amy Woodland Elementary required a new classroom as their enrollment went up.
- Fernie Secondary School and Isabella Dicken Elementary are up in enrollment.
- A new portable has been ordered for Isabella Dicken Elementary, currently there are 7 portables at the school.
- > Frank J. Mitchell Elementary and Mount Baker Secondary has not met their projections yet.
- Budget is looking good.
- Some schools are able to look at some clerical hour increases with the increased enrollment.

The next budget is due in February.
