# Framework for Enhancing Student Learning Survey

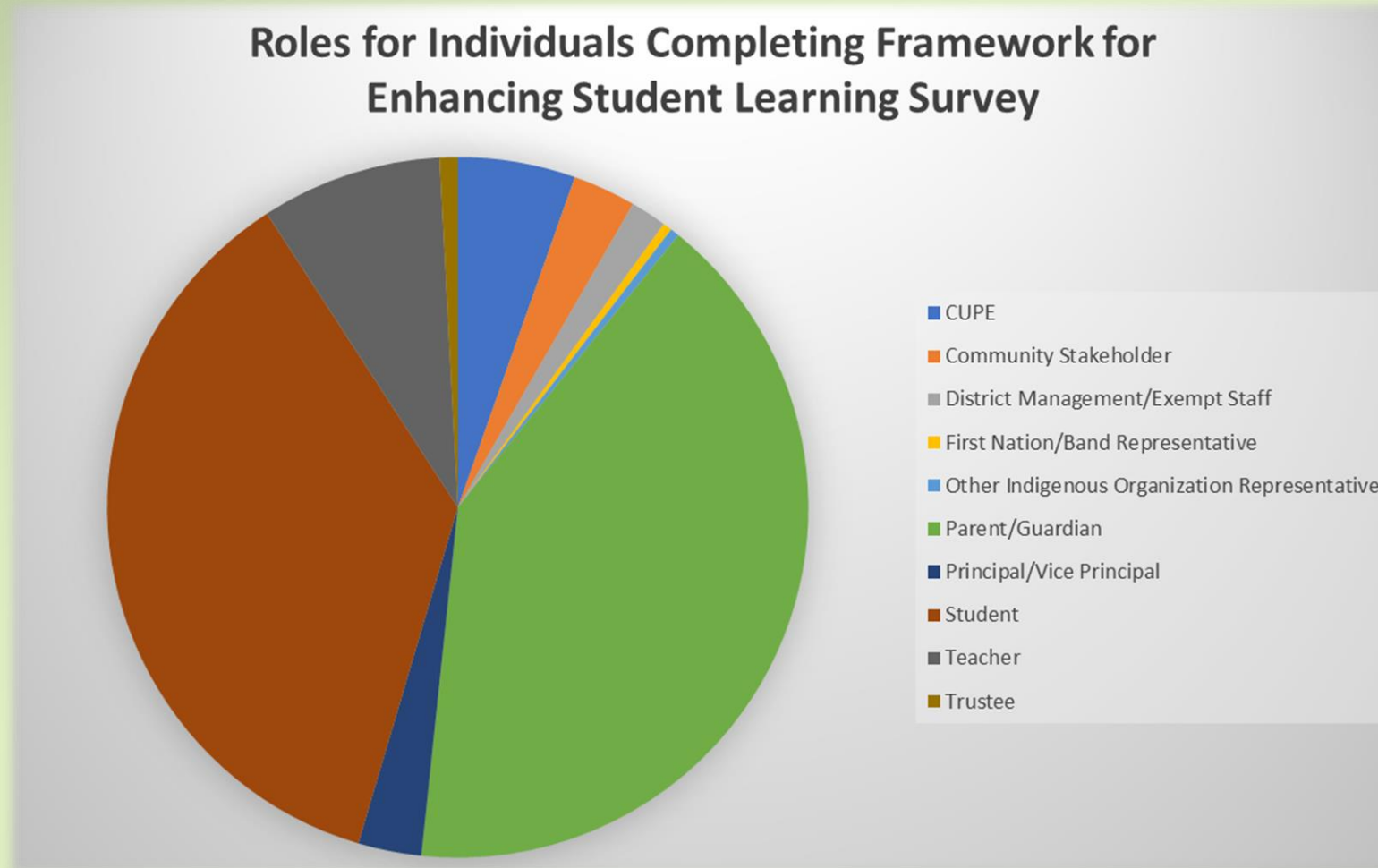
-  The Framework for Enhancing Student Learning (hereafter, the Framework) formalizes the planning and reporting expectations for school districts in order to enhance student learning and success. The Framework reflects a public commitment by Indigenous peoples and Indigenous rights holders, education partners and communities to work together to continuously improve student learning in relation to intellectual, human and social, and career development. The Framework requires alignment of provincial K-12 accountability and evidence-informed practices that enhance student learning, inclusivity and equity of outcomes. The Framework was led by the Ministry of Education and developed through authentic engagement with provincial education partners, and Indigenous rights holders.
-  A quality education system assists in the development of human potential and improves the well-being of every British Columbian. The B.C. school system develops educated citizens by supporting each student's intellectual, human and social, and career development, and by considering a wide range of information in all of these areas

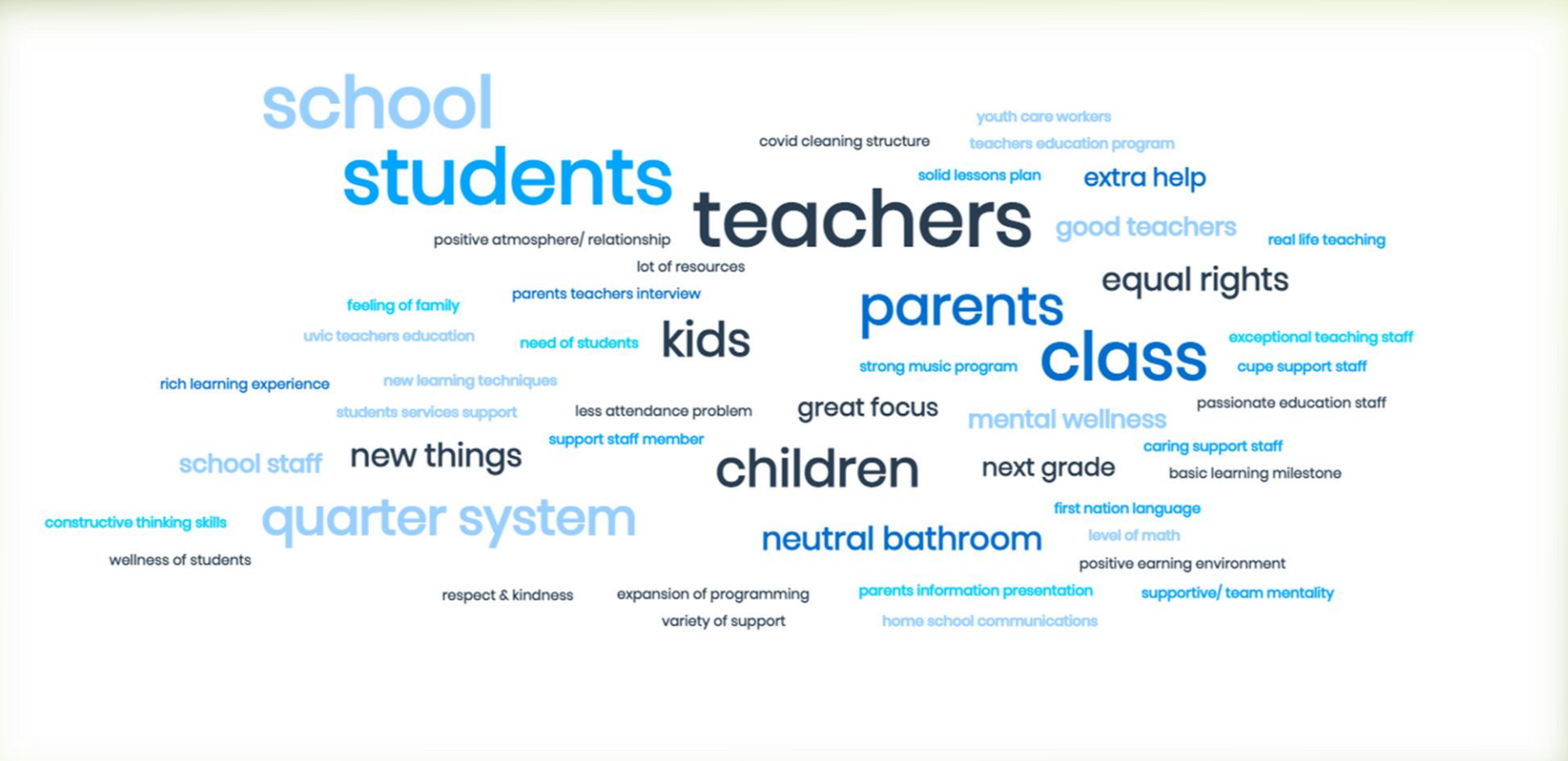

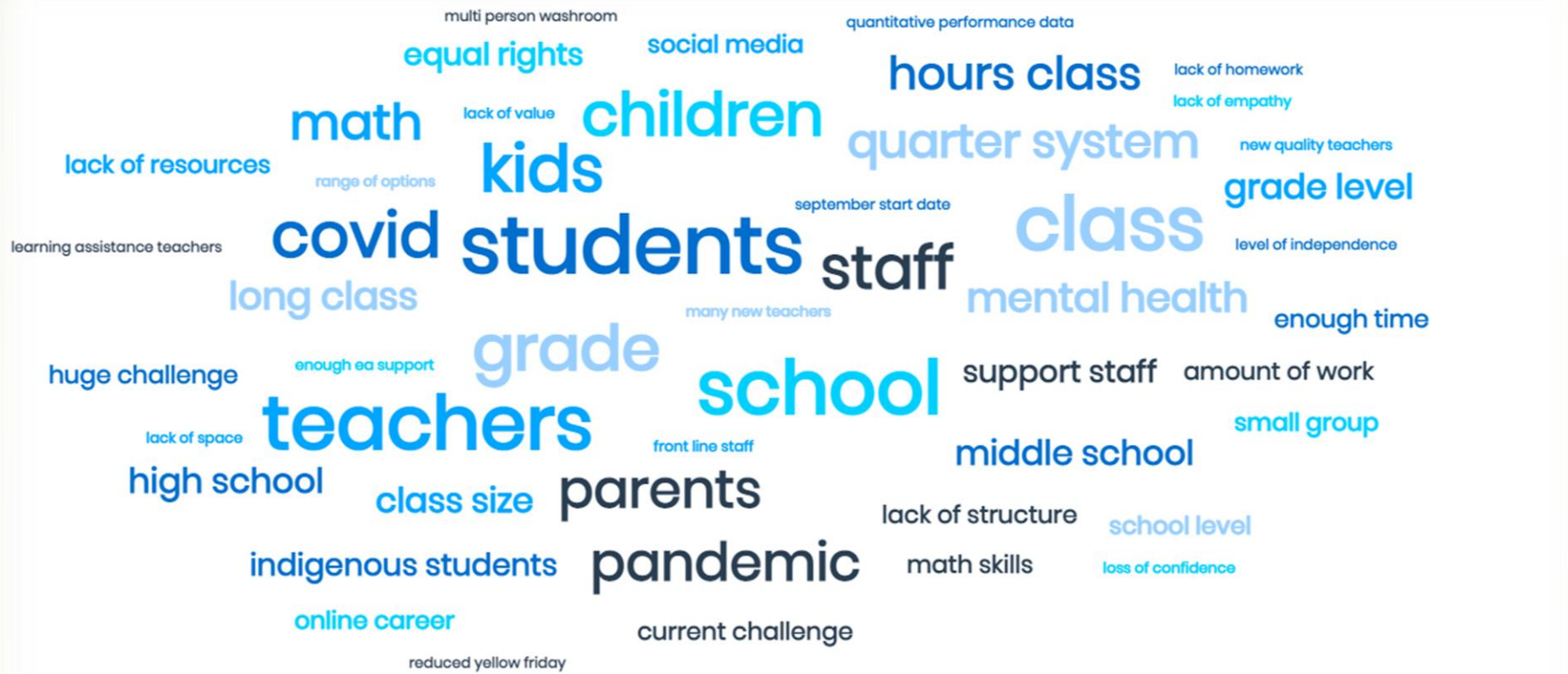
