<b>Recess</b>	Play appropriately on/with equipment Keep body to yourself Be aware of others Snow stays on the ground	Use kind words Invite others to play Hold the door open for others	Listen to supervisors Respect personal space Share equipment and take turns Respect the rules of games Outdoor shoes/boots off on mats	Put garbage into bins Head to school as soon as bell rings Bring equipment back into school Get help from supervisor if needed
<b>Lunchroom</b>	Eat your own food Stay seated while eating Keep body to yourself Water bottles/containers stay upright	Use polite words "Mind your own lunch"	Listen to supervisors and monitors Indoor voice only Food stays on your desk	Clean up all garbage Model good behavior for others Take uneaten food home
<b>Hallways</b>	Walking only Stay on right-hand side Head up, eyes forward Feet on the Ground	Wave or nod to someone Hands at your side	Walk quietly Bulletin boards are for eyes only Move to the side when extra space is needed	Go only where you are supposed to Indoor shoes on Stop and look when you get to a corner or T intersection
<b>Washroom/Changeroom</b>	Always flush Feet stay on the floor Wash hands well Fidgets/toys stay in classroom Food/drinks stay in the classroom	Leave lights on Leave doors unlocked Speak kindly to others	Stay in your space Take turns Give others privacy Be quick	Two soap pumps Turn off taps Garbage in the garbage bin Body waste stays in toilet/urinal 1-2-3 Save a tree
<b>Assembly</b>	Keep hands to self Sit criss-cross apple sauce Leave objects in the classroom	Enter and exit quietly Clap when appropriate	Stay in one spot Washroom before or after Appropriate and kind words only Listen to speaker	Whole body listening (eyes, ears, body pointed to speaker) Follow directions Keep fidgets to self
