

Cranbrook Ministerial Scholarship/Bursary Application

The member churches of the Cranbrook Ministerial Association are offering a \$1,000 scholarship/bursary to deserving candidates graduating from Mount Baker Secondary School. Applicants must indicate that they are intending to enroll in a post-secondary institution (including a Bible college, institute or lay-training facility for at least 6 months of studies). This scholarship must be used within 18 Months of completing grade 12. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

The selection of the successful candidate(s) will be based upon the following:

1. Academic standing - Grade 11 and Grade 12
2. Demonstration of financial need
3. Educational plans - priority given to those intending to complete a degree
4. A 200 word essay telling us how your Christian faith informs your career goals.
5. A letter of recommendation from your pastor or other Christian leader.
