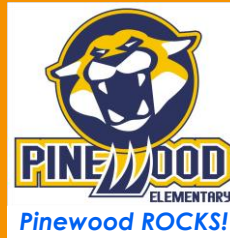

Greeting all! Let us cross our fingers that this cold snap will leave us. I am sure that many of us would like to see green sprouts and singing birds! Is that too much to ask?

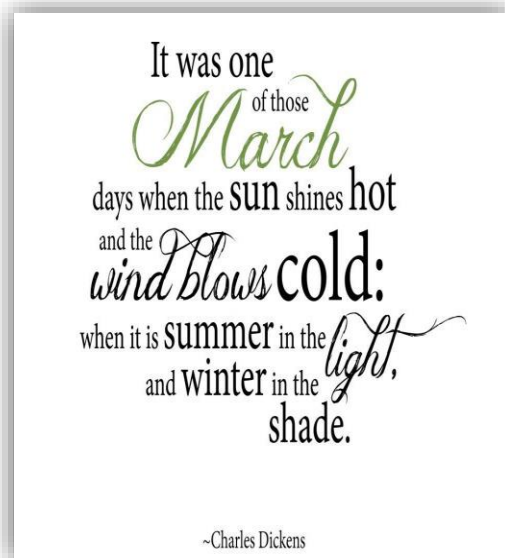
Although March is a short month in terms of school days, we certainly continue to play, discover, wonder and learn here at Pinewood. May we do the same with family and friends when we are on our March break.

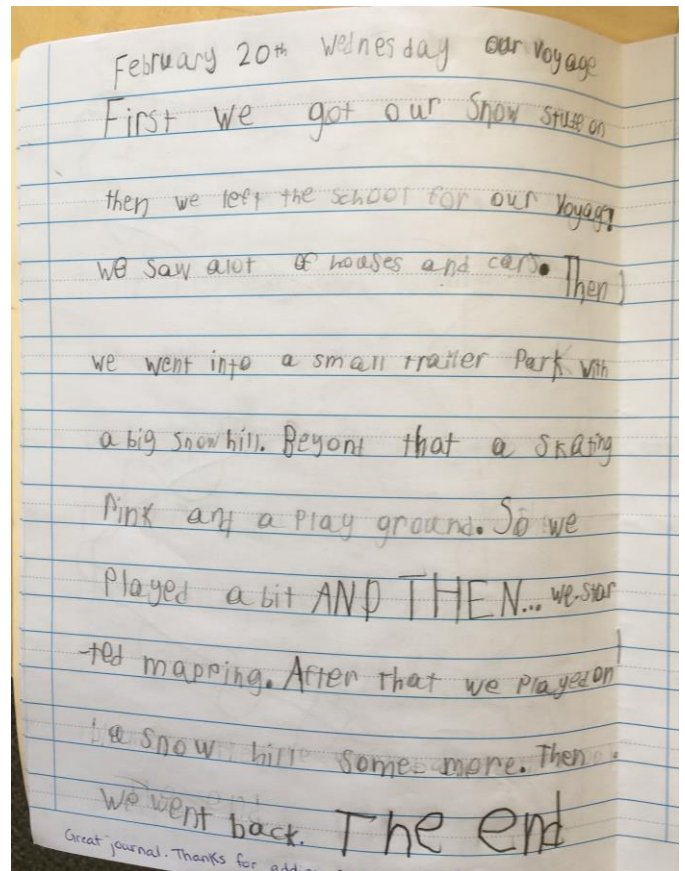
