We even had some students break some records throughout the day: Spencer Deutsch for the grade 4 boys 100 m in the preliminary with a time of 14.73 s, which was later broken by the top 5 boys in the final heat. Aiden Evans broke a district high jump record for grade 5 boys with a height of 1.30 m. Eve Stevenson broke two records in the grade 6 girls category. She set a new record of 13.60 s for the 100 m run, 29.44 s for the 200 m run. Congratulations to all of our athletes who participated.
