Parking at T.M.

TMRES is a large school, and we are growing! We have close to 385 students. As families come from all over town, we have a lot of cars doing morning drop-off and after school pick-up. To reduce congestion and to **keep our students safe** we have the following parking rules:

Quick Drop-off Loop:

- If you have to get out of your car, park somewhere other than the loop.
- Drive near the curb for drop off / pick up
- 30 sec Maximum stopping time;
- Do not leave your vehicle.
- Do not block entrance/exit to staff parking lot.

Staff Lot: No parent vehicles in staff parking lot, along back fence, or beside covered area.

No Parking at the old Masonic Hall: In previous years many parents used the old Masonic Hall at the end of the road for parking. This is now a private residence so please be respectful of our new neighbours.

Kindergarten Pickup: We ask that Kindergarten parents not use the drop-off loop as Kindergarten students are dismissed from their classroom and you must leave your car to pick them up.

Bus Lane: The front of the school is reserved for busses during school hours. Staff and parents cannot park along the curb that is painted yellow.

Thank you for helping us keep our students' safety a priority during this busy time.
