Most people are eligible for a FREE flu vaccine, either because they at risk themselves, or are a contact to those at risk of serious complications of influenza. This includes:

- anyone of any age with a chronic medical condition ie) diabetes, cancer, kidney or liver disease and their close contacts
- children age 6 mos to 59 months and their contacts
- pregnant women at any stage of pregnancy, their families & contacts
- seniors and their contacts,
- residents of care facilities and their contacts, care providers and visitors
- healthcare workers, first responders and social service providers, including those in private practice
- aboriginal persons
- obese persons
- anyone handling live poultry
