A reminder from the Ministry of Education

FOR ACTION, PARENTS – DUE AUG 14 – Apply for the BC Training & Education Savings: Children born in 2006 or later can qualify for a \$1,200 grant when they are signed up for a Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP). No RESP contribution is required. For children born in 2007, 2008 or 2009, the grant must be applied for by August 14, 2018, or the day before their ninth birthday, whichever is later. For children born in 2006, the deadline is August 14, 2019. For more information, please visit the webpage.
