School Cash Online

We are currently not ready to proceed with the new School Cash Online app and will keep you posted on our progress, advising you once we are ready. We still encourage you to register, to do so see the notes below.

It takes less than 5 minutes to register. Please follow these step-by-step instructions, so you will begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren) (ski trips, school fees etc.).

Step 1: Register. Go to <https://sd5.schoolcashonline.com>, and select “Get Started Today” Complete the registration steps. Passwords require 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

Step 2: Confirmation email. A registration confirmation email will be sent to you. Click on the link provided to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account.

Step 3: Find student. You will be prompted to find your child by using first and last name, as well as birth date. If you have more than one child, you can Add Another Student.
