Contests

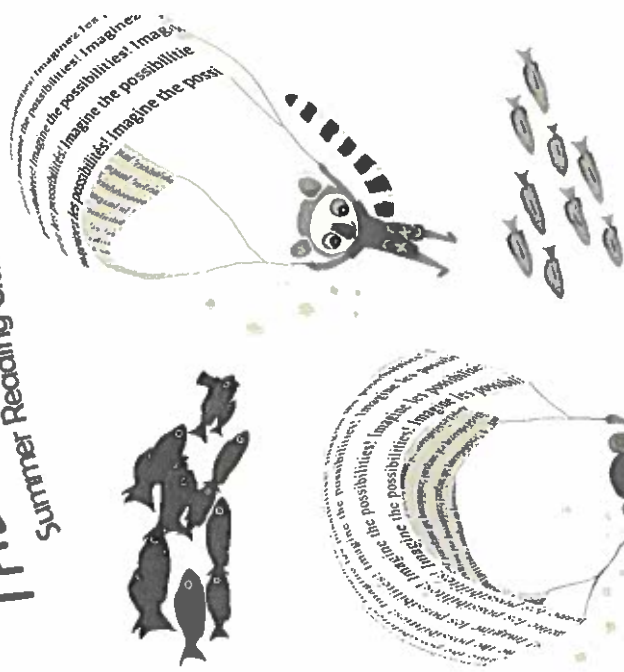

Week 2: Inventions and Innovations — inventors, gadgets, and doohickeys

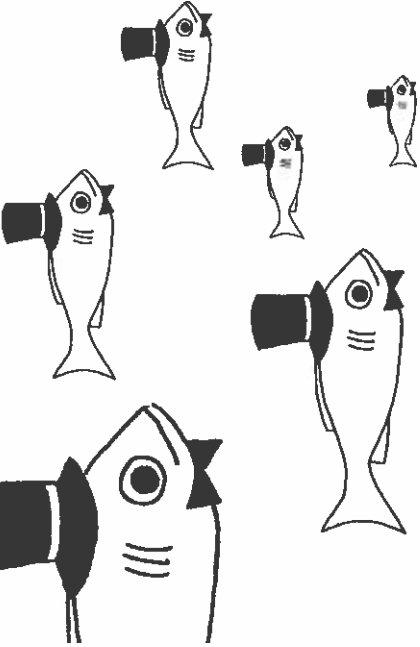
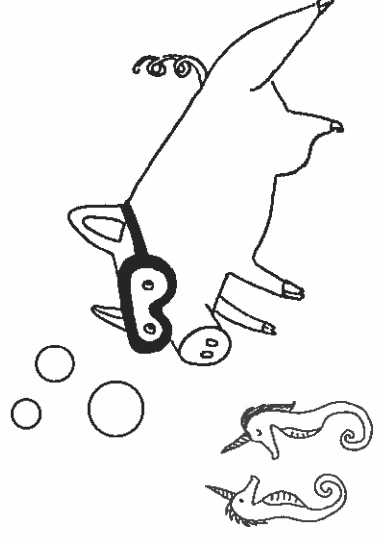
Week 3: Monsters and Make-Believe — mythical creatures and those under the bed

HOW IT WORKS

- 1) Register and receive a reading log.

- 4) Once 7 lines are filled out, visit the library to get a sticker on your completed section, a prize, and an entry form for a chance to win a weekly prize.
- 5) If you have filled out your entire reading log by **August 17 at 5pm**, you will receive a certificate and a medal at the Closing Ceremonies, where we celebrate our readers with door prizes, pizza and cake! The more logs you complete, the better your chances are of being this year's top reader!
