Apple Capture

Let's preserve apples together!

Wildsight is coming to our school to make apples into snacks. Students will use apples "captured" from trees around the community to make treats like sauce, juice and apple chips. Fruit trees are a wildlife attractant and using apples in this way helps reduce wildlife conflicts while providing food security.
