BC's Restart Plan

On May 6, Premier John Horgan announced [BC's Restart Plan](#), to restart BC's economy. Public health staff and officials will continue to review the health data while the Ministry of Education and school districts all around BC are reviewing options to allow for a safe return to school.

Parents will have the choice of bringing their children back to class on a part-time basis this school year as a part of BC's Restart Plan, with the goal of returning to full-time classes in September 2020, provided it is safe to do so. For Kindergarten to grade 5, this means most students will go to school half time to allow for 50% capacity.

In hopes of planning adequately for the return of our students to the classroom we require your feedback. The survey is aimed at ensuring safety protocols are considered and articulated, staff are available and facilities are prepared to welcome students safely.

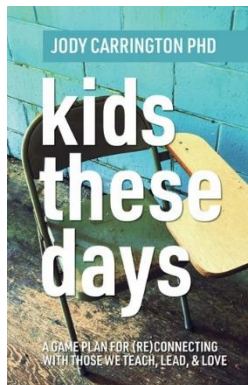
Student Information

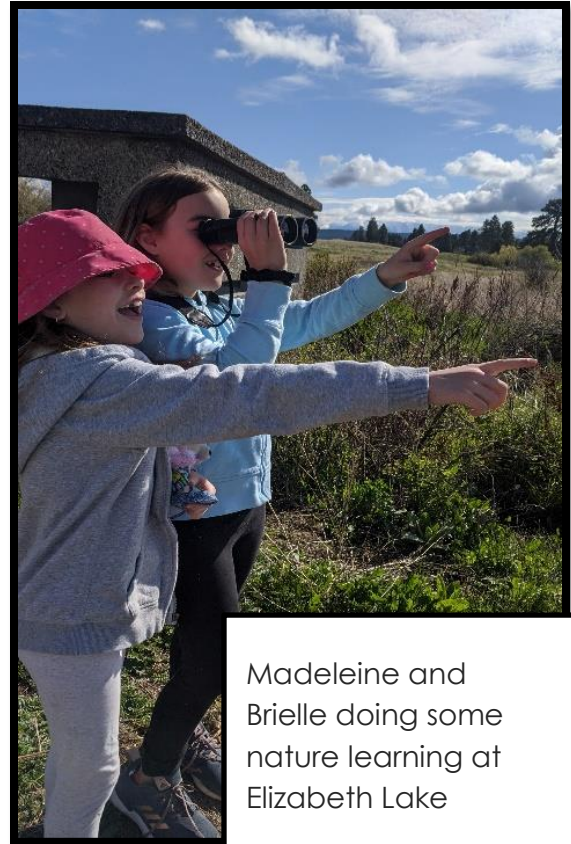
