School Cash Online

We will no longer be accepting cash at the office for the 2020-2021 school year.

TM Roberts is moving to online payments for student fees and field trip payments. **Take the time to register for Cash Online now in order to make the process smoother in September.** It takes less than 5 minutes to register. Please follow these step-by-step instructions, so you will begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren) (ski trips, school fees etc.).

Step 1: Register. Go to <https://sd5.schoolcashionline.com>, and select "Get Started Today"

Complete the registration steps. Passwords require 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

Step 2: Confirmation email. A registration confirmation email will be sent to you. Click on the link provided to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account.

Step 3: Find student. You will be prompted to find your child by using first and last name, as well as birth date. If you have more than one child, you can Add Another Student.
