

They also auctioned two tickets to Barney Bentall and the Cariboo Express, and we sold 25 raffle tickets.

Our road trip to visit Mayor and Council at the Town of Creston was cancelled on November 24th due to the great snowfall that morning, but has been rescheduled for December 15th.




